

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A PHILIPPINE TRAVEL DOCUMENT

1. Personal appearance of the applicant at the Consulate

2. Original Philippine Passport

If the original Philippine Passport is no longer available, applicant must:

- a. present original Birth Certificate issued by the National Statistics Office on Security Paper, duly authenticated by the Office of the President (Malacañang) and the Department of Foreign Affairs in Manila; other supporting documents (affidavit of Spouse etc.) and
- b. execute an Affidavit/Statement of Loss of Philippine Passport

3. Four (4) passport photos

4. Police Report of Loss

5. Original return ticket to the Philippines

6. Fee/s payable upon personal appearance at the Consulate:

- a. €27.00 - Travel Document

Fees are subject to change without prior notice. Fees prevailing at the time of processing of applications will apply.

The Consulate may require such other documents necessary to establish applicant's Filipino citizenship.
